The A61 Trunk Road (Tankersley Roundabout, Birdwell to Old County Borough Boundary, Barnsley) (Detrunking) Order 1995

Made - - - - *4th April 1995*
Coming into force - - *5th May 1995*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980⁽¹⁾, and now vested in him ⁽²⁾, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf:—

1. This Order may be cited as the A61 Trunk Road (Tankersley Roundabout, Birdwell to Old County Borough Boundary, Barnsley) (Detrunking) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 5th May 1995.

| (iii) “the trunk road” | means the Exeter—Leeds Trunk Road (A61). |

THE SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF THE TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

The length of the trunk road ceasing to be a trunk road is situated between Tankersley Roundabout, Birdwell (marked A on the plan) and the Old County Borough Boundary, Barnsley (marked B on the plan), all in the Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley, a total distance of approximately 5.50 kilometres. That length is shown by broad black dashes on the plan.
