The Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) Order 1995

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 8th day of February 1995 Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 13 of the Child Abduction and Custody Act 1985(1), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) Order 1995, and shall come into force on 1st March 1995.
- (2) The Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) (No. 5) Order 1994(2) is revoked.
- **2.** For Schedule 2 to the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) Order 1986(**3**) there shall be substituted the following—
