**The Gwent Community Health National Health  
Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1995**

*Made - - - - 19th October 1995*  
*Coming into force - - 1st November 1995*

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and Section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Gwent Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1995 and shall come into force on 1st November 1995.

**Amendment of NHS Trust Establishment Order**

2. In Article 4 of the Gwent Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1992<sup>(3)</sup> for “5 non-executive” there shall be substituted “4 non-executive” and for “5 executive” there shall be substituted “4 executive”.
