# The Gwent Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1995 

Made - - - - 19th October 1995

Coming into force - - 1st November 1995

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act $1977(\mathbf{1})$ and Section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990(2) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

## Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Gwent Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1995 and shall come into force on 1st November 1995.

## Amendment of NHS Trust Establishment Order

2. In Article 4 of the Gwent Community Health National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1992(3) for " 5 non-executive" there shall be substituted " 4 non-executive" and for " 5 executive" there shall be substituted " 4 executive".
