#### Title, extent and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Habitat (Salt-Marsh) (Correction to Amendment) Regulations 1995, shall extend to England and shall come into force on 30th November 1995.

### Correction to the Habitat (Salt-Marsh) (Amendment) Regulations 1995

**2.** In regulation 3 of the Habitat (Salt-Marsh) (Amendment) Regulations 1995(**3**), for "Regulations 4 to 7" substitute "regulations 4 to 9".
