URBAN DEVELOPMENT

The Bristol Development Corporation (Dissolution) Order 1995

Made - - - - *20th December 1995*

Coming into force - - *1st January 1996*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 166 of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(1), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having consulted the councils of the County of Avon and the City of Bristol, hereby makes the following Order—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Bristol Development Corporation (Dissolution) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 1st January 1996.

Dissolution of the corporation

2. The Bristol Development Corporation shall be dissolved on 1st April 1996.
