**The Financial Services Act 1986 (Gas Industry Exemption) (Amendment) Order 1996**

The Treasury in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46(1) and section 205A(2) of the Financial Services Act 1986(3), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Financial Services Act 1986 (Gas Industry Exemption) (Amendment) Order 1996 and shall come into force on 22nd May 1996.

**Amendments**

2. In article 1 of the Financial Services (Gas Industry Exemption) Order(4) the words“Financial Services Act 1986 (Gas Industry Exemption) Order 1996” shall be substituted for the words “Financial Services (Gas Industry Exemption) Order”.
