## The Local Government Reorganisation (Wales) (Staff) (No. 3) Order 1996

## Interpretation

**2.**—(1) In this Order—

"the 1994 Act" means the Local Government (Wales) Act 1994;

"new authority" means a county or county borough council which is established under the 1994 Act or a National Park authority established by article 3 of the National Park Authorities (Wales) Order 1995(1);

"old authority" means a county or district council which ceased to exist as a result of the 1994 Act:

"the No. 2 Order" means the Local Government Reorganisation (Wales) (Staff) (No. 2) Order 1996(2);

"the principal Order" means the Local Government Reorganisation (Wales) (Staff) Order 1996(3).

- (2) Persons described in this Order are described by reference to their name and one or more of the following—
  - (a) their employee number with the old authority which number is given in brackets,
  - (b) the title or description of the post,
  - (c) the establishment at which, or the geographic area within which, the person worked immediately before 1st April 1996.
