**The Local Government Reorganisation
(Wales) (Staff) (No. 3) Order 1996**

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this Order—

“the 1994 Act” means the Local Government (Wales) Act 1994;

“new authority” means a county or county borough council which is established under the 1994 Act or a National Park authority established by article 3 of the National Park Authorities (Wales) Order 1995⁽¹⁾;

“old authority” means a county or district council which ceased to exist as a result of the 1994 Act;

“the No. 2 Order” means the Local Government Reorganisation (Wales) (Staff) (No. 2) Order 1996⁽²⁾;

“the principal Order” means the Local Government Reorganisation (Wales) (Staff) Order 1996⁽³⁾.

(2) Persons described in this Order are described by reference to their name and one or more of the following—

- (a) their employee number with the old authority which number is given in brackets,
- (b) the title or description of the post,
- (c) the establishment at which, or the geographic area within which, the person worked immediately before 1st April 1996.

Article 16 of that Order has the effect that references to a new principal council which may be specified as a new employer for the purposes of section 42(2) and (3) of the 1994 Act include reference to a National Park authority in Wales.
