# NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Royal Surrey County and St. Luke's Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Transfer of Trust Property) Order 1996

Made	2nd July 1996
Laid before Parliament	9th July 1996
Coming into force	31st July 1996

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 92(1) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having regard to the change in the arrangements for the administration of hospitals and other establishments and facilities previously managed by the former South West Surrey Health Authority resulting from the establishment of the Royal Surrey County and St. Luke's Hospitals National Health Service Trust(2), having consulted the former Western Surrey Health Authority(3) and that Trust in accordance with section 92(3) of that Act, hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Royal Surrey County and St. Luke's Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Transfer of Trust Property) Order 1996, and shall come into force on 31st July 1996.

(2) In this Order—

"the Authority" means the West Surrey Health Authority established on 1st April 1996(4);

"the old Authority" means the Western Surrey Health Authority established on 1st April 1995(5) and abolished on 1st April 1996(6);

"the Trust" means the Royal Surrey County and St. Luke's Hospitals National Health Service Trust;

"the trust property" means the items specified in a schedule of trust property prepared by and agreed upon by the old Authority and the Trust on 30th November 1995, which schedule has been signed on behalf of both the old Authority and the Trust.

### Transfer of trust property

2. On 31st July 1996 the trust property shall be transferred from the Authority to the Trust.
