**The Essex Ambulance Service National Health  
Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1996**

*Made* - - - - *14th October 1996*  
*Coming into force* - - *28th October 1996*

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Essex Ambulance Service National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1996 and shall come into force on 28th October 1996.

**Amendment of NHS trust Establishment Order**

2. In Article 4 of the Essex Ambulance Service National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1991<sup>(3)</sup> for “5 non-executive” there shall be substituted “4 non-executive” and for “5 executive” there shall be substituted “4 executive”.
