## **BROADCASTING**

The Channel 4 (Application of Excess Revenues) Order 1996

Made - - - - 10th December 1996 Coming into force - - 11th December 1996

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 27(7) of the Broadcasting Act 1990(1), hereby makes the following Order a draft of which has been laid before and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the Channel 4 (Application of Excess Revenues) Order 1996 and shall come into force on the day after the day on which it is made.
  - 2. In section 27(3)(a) of the Broadcasting Act 1990(2), for "50 per cent" substitute "nil per cent".
