**The A30 Trunk Road (Great South West Road, Hounslow) Red Route (Prescribed Routes and Prohibitive Turns No. 2) Traffic Order 1996**

**Interpretation**

**2.** In this Order—

- (a) causing includes permitting, and cause shall be construed accordingly;
- (b) any reference to a named road is to the road bearing that name in the London Borough of Hounslow;
- (c) “the trunk road” means that length of the A30 trunk road, known as the Great South West Road, which lies in the London Borough of Hounslow;
- (d) “The Parkway island no. 1” means the triangular island site situated at or adjacent to the junction of the trunk road and the western carriageway of The Parkway;
- (e) “The Parkway island no. 2” means the triangular island site situated at or adjacent to the junction of the trunk road and the eastern carriageway of The Parkway;
- (f) “The Causeway island” means the triangular island site situated at or adjacent to the junction of the trunk road and the western carriageway of The Causeway;
- (g) “bus” means a vehicle to which regulation 22(2) of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994<sup>(1)</sup>.
