**The Hull and Holderness Community Health National
Health Service Trust (Transfer of Trust Property) Order 1996**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92(1) of the National Health Service Act 1977⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having regard to the change in the arrangements for the administration of hospitals and other establishments and facilities formerly managed by the East Riding Health Authority resulting from the establishment of the Hull and Holderness Community Health National Health Service Trust⁽²⁾, having consulted that Trust and the Royal Hull Hospitals National Health Service Trust⁽³⁾ in accordance with section 92(3) of that Act, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Hull and Holderness Community Health National Health Service Trust (Transfer of Trust Property) Order 1996 and shall come into force on 16th February 1996.

(2) In this Order—

“the first Trust” means the Royal Hull Hospitals National Health Service Trust;

“the second Trust” means the Hull and Holderness Community Health National Health Service Trust;

“the trust property” means the items specified in a schedule of trust property prepared by and agreed upon by the first Trust and the second Trust on 26th October 1995, which schedule has been signed on behalf of both the first Trust and the second Trust.
