**The Sheffield Development  
Corporation (Dissolution) Order 1997**

*Made* - - - - 24th March 1997  
*Coming into force* - - 1st April 1997

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 166 of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(1), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having consulted the council of the City of Sheffield, hereby makes the following Order—

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Sheffield Development Corporation (Dissolution) Order 1997 and shall come into force on 1st April 1997.

**Dissolution of the corporation**

2. The Sheffield Development Corporation shall be dissolved on 1st July 1997.
