**The Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland)
Act 1995 (Detention by Customs Officers)
(Specification of Titles) Order 1997**

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 26(11) of the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995(1), hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995 (Detention by Customs Officers) (Specification of Titles) Order 1997 and shall come into force on 1st October 1997.

2. The following titles are specified for the purposes of the definition of “superior officer” in section 26(11) of the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995—

- (a) Anti-Smuggling Manager;
- (b) Cargo Operational Manager;
- (c) Investigation Team Leader;
- (d) Passenger Services Division Operations Manager; and

any other title within job band 9.
