The Education (Disability Statements for Local Education Authorities) (Wales) Regulations 1997

Information to be contained in disability statements

2. Information contained in a disability statement about the provision of facilities for further education made by the authority in respect of disabled persons shall cover the following matters—

- (a) the policies of the authority relating to the provision of facilities for further education;
- (b) the names of, and the titles of posts held by, members of the staff of the authority with special responsibilities for disabled persons specifying in each case whether the member of the staff has such responsibilities in respect of all facilities for further education secured by the authority or in respect only of such facilities provided at particular institutions;
- (c) the names of, and the titles of the posts held by, members of the staff of the authority from whom information about admission arrangements can be obtained;
- (d) educational facilities and support provided by the authority specifically for disabled persons;
- (e) arrangements for handling complaints and (where applicable) appeals in respect of any of the matters mentioned in paragraphs (d) above or (f) and (g) below;
- (f) additional support or special arrangements during examinations and assessments;
- (g) physical access to educational and other facilities;
- (h) any special arrangements made by the authority as to fees charged for the provision of further education (including special arrangements for the provision of such facilities without charge).
