3. The Court of Session shall have power—

- (a) to grant interim interdict under subsection (1)(c) of section 27 of the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982;
- (b) to act as described in section 28 of that Act,

in relation to proceedings which are to be commenced otherwise than in ^{F1}... [^{F2} a 2005 Hague Convention State].
