The Education (Transfer of Functions Relating to Grant-maintained Schools) Order 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to, and section 568(6) of, the Education Act 1996(1), the Secretary of State for Education and Employment hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Education (Transfer of Functions Relating to Grant-maintained Schools) Order 1997, and shall come into force on 5th March 1997.

Revocation

2. The Education (Transfer of Functions Relating to Grant-maintained Schools) Order 1996(**2**) is hereby revoked.

Transfer of functions relating to grant-maintained schools

3. The power of the Secretary of State under section 231(6) of the Education Act 1996 to consent to borrowing by grant-maintained schools, mentioned in paragraph 1(2) of Schedule 3 to that Act, shall be exercisable instead, in relation to England, by the Funding Agency for Schools(**3**).
