**Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Children's Hearings (Scotland) Rules 1986 etc (Revocations) (Scotland) Rules 1997 and shall come into force on 1st April 1997.

**Revocations**

2. The following Rules shall be revoked on 1st April 1997—
- The Children's Hearings (Scotland) Rules 1986<sup>(3)</sup>;
  - The Children's Hearings (Scotland) Amendment Rules 1996<sup>(4)</sup>;
  - The Reporter's Duties and Transmission of Information, etc. (Scotland) Rules 1971<sup>(5)</sup>.
