**The Protection from Harassment Act
1997 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1998**

Made - - - - 30th July 1998

Coming into force - - 1st September 1998

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 15(2) of the Protection from Harassment Act 1997⁽¹⁾, hereby makes the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protection from Harassment Act 1997 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1998.
2. Subsections (3) to (9) of section 3 of the Protection from Harassment Act 1997 shall come into force on 1st September 1998.
