It is - with certain statutory exceptions - an offence for a person to have in his possession, purchase or acquire, any shot gun, without holding a shot gun certificate. A shot gun is defined as: a smooth-bore gun (not being an air weapon) which - a has a barrel not less than 60.96 cm (24 inches) in length and does not have any barrel with a bore-exceeding 5.06 cm (two inches) in diameter; b either has no magazine or a non-detachable magazine incapable of holding more than two cartridges; and c is not a revolver gun. Other smooth bore gues may require a finarm certificate. A shot gun certificate is granted subject to the conditions prescribed by the Birearms Rules 1998. It is an offence to fail to comply with any condition shown on a shot gun certificate. In answering question 14 you are not entitled to withhold information about any offence. This includes motoring offence, connictions in places outside Great Britain, and (by virtue of the Relabilitation of Offencers Act 1974 (Exceptions) Order 1975) connictions which are spent under the 1974 Act. Both a conditional discharge and an absolute discharge count as convictions for this purpose.	This form must be accompanied by four identical photographs of you. the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1997 requires you to notify the chief officer of police who issued your certificate.

This requirement applies even if the sale, loss, etc has happened. outside Great Britain. It is an offence not to notify. Details of the notifications required are available from your local polics.

C. Under section 32 of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1997 where a person sells, lets on hire, lends for more than 72 hours or gives a shot gun to another person who is not a registered firearms dealer or a

person who is entitled to purchase or acquire the shot gun without holding a certificate

- the person receiving the shot gun must produce the certificate or permit entitling him/her to purchase or acquire the shot gun being transferred;
- the person selling, letting on hirs, lending or giving the shot gun must comply with any instructions in the certificate or permit produced; and
- iii) the final hand over of the shot gun must take place in person. It is an offence for a person to fail to comply with these requirements.

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
