The Dissolution of the Cable Authority Order 1998

Made - - - - 9th September 1998

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 128(2) and (5) of the Broadcasting Act 1990⁽¹⁾, and having consulted the Cable Authority and the Independent Television Commission, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Dissolution of the Cable Authority Order 1998.
2. The Cable Authority are hereby dissolved with effect from 10th September 1998.
