# **SPORTS GROUNDS AND SPORTING EVENTS**

The Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 1998

Made	15th September 1998
Laid before Parliament	21st September 1998
Coming into force	13th October 1998

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 18 of the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 13th October 1998.

**2.** For the purposes of Part II of the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995 there are hereby designated–

- (a) the sports grounds specified in Parts I, II and III of Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (b) the classes of sporting events specified in Part I of Schedule 2 to this Order, at any of the sports grounds specified in Parts I and II of Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (c) the class of sporting event specified in Part II of Schedule 2 to this Order, at the sports grounds specified in Parts II and III of Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (d) the classes of sporting events specified in Part III of Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. The Orders specified in Schedule 3 to this Order are hereby revoked.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates the sports grounds, the classes of sporting events played at those grounds and the classes of sporting events outside Great Britain for the purposes of Part II of the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995. This Order revokes the Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 1985 and the subsequent Orders amending that Order.
