The Immigration (Transit Visa) (Amendment No. 3)Order 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 1A(1) and (2) of the Immigration (Carriers' Liability) Act 1987(1), the Secretary of State hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Transit Visa) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 8th October 1998.

2. For the Schedule to the Immigration (Transit Visa) Order 1993(**2**) there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order.

3. Article 2 of and the Schedule to the Immigration (Transit Visa) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1998(**3**) are hereby revoked.
