**The Southampton Community Health Services National
Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1998**

Made - - - - - *9th December 1998*

Coming into force - - - - - *21st December 1998*

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1) and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990(2) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having completed the consultation prescribed under section 5(2) of that latter Act(3) and considering it appropriate that the functions of the trust should include functions in relation to the provision of services for one or more Health Authorities(4), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Southampton Community Health Services National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1998 and shall come into force on 21st December 1998.

Amendment of Establishment Order

2. In the Southampton Community Health Services National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1992(5):—

(a) for Article 3 there shall be substituted the following Article:—

“Nature and functions of the trust

3.—(1) The trust is established for the purposes specified in section 5(1) of the Act.

- (2) The trust's functions shall be:—
- (a) to own and manage pursuant to section 5(1)(a) of the Act the premises specified in Part I of the Schedule to this Order, and there to provide and manage hospital accommodation and services;
 - (b) to provide and manage pursuant to section 5(1)(b) of the Act the premises specified in Part II of the Schedule to this Order and there to provide and manage hospital accommodation and services; and
 - (c) to own and manage pursuant to section 5(1)(a) of the Act Central Health Clinic, East Park Terrace, Southampton SO14 0YL and associated premises, and from there to provide and manage community health services.”; and
- (b) at the end there shall be added the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order.
