# LOCAL GOVERNMENT, SCOTLAND

The Moray (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1998

Made - - - - 16th December 1998

Coming into force - - 1st January 1999

Whereas under section 17(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(1), as read with Schedule 5 to that Act(2), the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland on 3rd April 1998 submitted to the Secretary of State a report on a review together with its proposals for the future electoral arrangements for the area of Moray Council;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 17(2) and 233(3) of, and Schedule 5 to, the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following Order:

### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Moray (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 1st January 1999.

## Interpretation

- 2. In the Schedule to this Order-
  - (a) a reference to-
    - (i) an electoral ward is a reference to that electoral ward as constituted in this Order; and
    - (ii) a road, footpath, railway line, river, burn or canal shall, where the context so admits, be construed as a reference to the centre line of the feature concerned; and
  - (b) the following abbreviations are used:-
  - "EW" for electoral ward;
  - "NG Ref" for National Grid Reference as published on Ordnance Survey Maps.

# **Electoral arrangements**

**3.** The area of Moray Council shall be divided into 26 wards, having the names, contents and boundaries set forth in the Schedule to this Order.

## SCHEDULE Article 3

## **ELECTORAL WARDS**

# Ward 1 Elgin - Bishopmill West

Commencing on the River Lossie at NG Ref NJ 1937 6260; then northward in a straight line to the northern boundary of Oak Wood where it meets the eastern boundary of Quarry Wood; then northeastward to the junction of the track and the unclassified road southeast of Woodside Stud; then continuing northeastward along the said track to the B9012 road; then southeastward along the said road to a point in line with the northern boundary of Spynie Hospital; then northeastward in a straight line to the said boundary and the line of a field boundary; then northwestward, northeastward, southeastward and northeastward along the line of field boundaries to NG Ref NJ 2132 6454 and continuing northeastward in a straight line to NG Ref NJ 2183 6479 on Lossiemouth Road; then generally southward along Lossiemouth Road to the junction with North Street; then generally southward along the said street to the River Lossie; then generally westward along the said river to the point of commencement.

# Ward 2 Elgin – Bishopmill East

Commencing at the junction of the northern and eastern boundaries of EW 1 (Elgin – Bishopmill West) on Lossiemouth Road in line with field boundaries leading eastward from NG Ref NJ 2183 6479 and passing immediately to the north of Muir of Linksfield; then generally northeastward along the said field boundaries to and southward along the access road to Spynie to the unclassified road leading past Linksfield Crossing and Wester Calcots; then generally southeastward and southward along the said road and its prolongation in a straight line to the northern boundary of Kirkhill Wood; then generally southeastward along the northern and eastern boundaries of the said wood; then southward to and westward along the River Lossie to a point in line with the rear curtilage of No 8 Findhorn Court; then northward along the rear curtilages of Nos 7 to 1 Findhorn Court to and generally northward along the path leading to Riverside Drive; then southwestward along Riverside Drive to Newmill Road; then generally northward along the said road to and westward along the southern boundary of Deanshaugh playing field to the River Lossie; then generally westward along the said river to and northward along the eastern boundary of EW 1 to the point of commencement.

# Ward 3 Elgin - Cathedral

Commencing on the western and southern boundaries of EW 2 (Elgin – Bishopmill East) on the River Lossie; then generally eastward along the southern boundary of EW 2 to its confluence with the Burn of Linkwood; then generally southwestward along the said burn to the bridge carrying the Inverness to Aberdeen railway; then westward along the said railway to the point at which it is crossed by New Elgin Road; then northeastward along the railway track leading to the Goods Station to a point in line with the footpath running to the rear of the eastern curtilages of properties on Duff Avenue; then generally northwestward along the said footpath to Institution Road; then generally southwestward along the said road to and northwestward along Abbey Street and Glover Street to High Street; then westward along the said street to and northward along Lossie Wynd to Alexandra Road; then westward along the said road to a point in line with Cumming Street; then northward to and along the said street to North Street; then northward along the said street to the point of commencement.

# Ward 4 Elgin – Central West

Commencing on the River Lossie and the southern boundary of EW 1 (Elgin – Bishopmill West) on the eastern boundary of the property known as Gallowhill; then generally eastward along the said

boundary to its junction with the western boundary of EW 3 (Elgin – Cathedral); then generally southeastward and southwestward along the said EW boundary to the point where the railway track leading to the Goods Station is crossed by New Elgin Road; then westward along the said railway to the point where it crosses the River Lossie; then generally northwestward southwestward, northward and northeastward along the River Lossie to the point of commencement.

# Ward 5 New Elgin West

Commencing on the southern boundary of EW 4 (Elgin – Central West) at a point where the Inverness to Aberdeen railway line crosses the River Lossie; then eastward along the said EW boundary to the point where the railway line is crossed by New Elgin Road; then southeastward along New Elgin Road to a point in line with the southeastern boundary of the Dookit Park playing field and the northwestern boundary of No 10 New Elgin Road; then southwestward and southeastward along the eastern boundary of the said playing field to North Street; then southwestward along North Street and Springfield Road to its junction with Gordon Street; then southward along Gordon Street to its junction with Birnie Road; then southwestward and southward along Birnie Road to the track along the eastern margin of Mayne Wood; then northwestward along the said track to a point due west of Hardhillock Golf Club House; then due westward in a straight line to and northwestward and southwestward along the western margin of Mayne Wood to the line of field boundaries leading southwestward from the southern end of the access road past Mayne House; then continuing southwestward along the said field boundaries to the River Lossie; then generally northward along the River Lossie to the point of commencement.

# Ward 6 New Elgin East

Commencing on the western and southern boundary of EW 3 (Elgin – Cathedral); then eastward along the said EW southern boundary to a point where the Inverness to Aberdeen railway is crossed by Reiket Lane; then southwestward and southward along Reiket Lane to its junction with the unclassified road leading to Linkwood; then northwestward along the said unclassified road to its junction with the southern boundary of the Public House at NG Ref NJ 2292 6166; then southwestward and northwestward along the said boundary to the junction with Thornhill Road; then southwestward along Thornhill Road crossing the A941(T) road and continuing generally southwestward along Birnie Road to its junction with Gordon Street and the eastern boundary of EW 5 (New Elgin – West); then generally northward, northeastward and northwestward along the said EW boundary to the point of commencement.

#### **Ward 7 Forres East**

Commencing at the point where the Inverness to Aberdeen railway line crosses the Burn of Mosset; then northeastward along the said railway line to a point in line with the unnamed road leading from the B9011 road to the A96 (T) road west of Cassieford; then southeastward to and along the said unnamed road to the A96(T) road; then generally westward along the A96(T) road to a point in line with the access road to Lochyhill; then southeastward along the said access road and its continuation southwestward to its junction with the unclassified road leading to Easter New Forres; then southeastward along the said unclassified road to the track leading through Muiry Wood to the B9010 road; then southward and southwestward along the said track to the B9010 road; then northwestward along the said road to a point in line with the eastern curtilage of the properties on the south side of St Leonards Road; then southward and westward along the eastern and southern boundaries of the properties of the south of St Leonard's Road to the access track leading to Chapelton Farm; then southwestward and northwestward along the eastern and southern boundaries of Sanquhar Woodlands to the point where it meets the access road to Sanquhar Mains at NG Ref NJ 0377 5724; then northward and westward along the said track to

the point where it crosses the line of the dismantled railway line; then generally northward along the line of the dismantled railway to a point in line with the rear curtilages of the properties on the south side of Mannachie Rise; then northeastward and northward along the rear curtilages of Nos 53 to 29 Mannachie Rise to the rear curtilage of No 1 Lochview Grove; then generally northward along the rear curtilages of Nos 2 to 3 Lochview Grove and continuing northward by the line of a field boundary to the path leading to Macdonald Drive; then generally northeastward to a point at NG Ref NJ 0380 5807 on the Burn of Mosset south of Forres Academy; then northeastward in straight line to Sanquhar Road; then generally northward along the said road to South Street; then northeastward and northwestward along South Street to High Street; then generally southwestward along High Street to its junction with North Street; then northwestward along the said street to its junction with Gordon Street; then northwestward along the said street to Burn of Mosset; then generally northward along the said burn to the point of commencement.

#### **Ward 8 Forres Central**

Commencing at the point where the northern boundary meets the western boundary of EW 7 (Forres East) on the Inverness to Aberdeen railway line; then generally southeastward, northeastward and southward along the western boundary of EW 7 to the point where the access track to Sanquhar Mains crosses the line of the dismantled railway; then westward along the said track to Manachy Road; then southward along the said road to a point in line with the field boundary immediately to the south Balnaferry Farm; then westward to and along the said field boundary and continuing generally northwestward along the line of a field boundary to the A940 road; then generally northeastward along the said road to the junction with the access track to Thornhill Farm; then northwestward to and along the said track to NG Ref NJ 0305 5829; then southwestward, northwestward and generally northeastward along the line of boundaries to the western curtilage of the properties in Wellside Court; then northwestward along the said curtilage and continuing northwestward to and along the rear curtilages of the properties on the western side of Councillors Walk to the southern curtilage of No 3 Pilmuir Road; then northeastward along the rear boundaries of No's 3 and 1 Pilmuir Road to Councillors Walk; then northwestward along the said road to West Park Road; then northwestward along the said road to the B9011; then southwestward along the B9011 to the junction with the A96 road; then northward to and along the unnamed road leading to Greeshop House to the point it is crossed by the Inverness to Aberdeen railway line; then northeastward along the said railway line to the point of commencement.

## Ward 9 Finderne

Commencing at NG Ref NH 9478 6162 where the western boundary meets the northern boundary of The Moray Council; then generally northeastward along the northern boundary of The Moray Council to a point at NG Ref NJ 0973 6530; then generally eastward then southward along the Bessie Burn to NG Ref NJ 1029 6466; then southward and northeastward along the line of a field boundary to NG Ref NJ 1075 6481; then southeastward along the line of a drain and field fence crossing the B9089 road at NG Ref NJ 1103 6442 and continuing southeastward along field boundaries to the surfaced road at NG Ref NJ 1161 6359; then southwestward along the said road to its junction with surfaced road NG Ref NJ 0930 6272; then southeastward along the said road to its junction with the A96 road at NG Ref NJ 0984 6097; then southwestward along the said road to its junction with a field drain at NG Ref NJ 0926 6059; then southwestward along the said drain to a point at NG Ref NJ 0680 5890; then northwestward along the line of a field boundary to its junction with surfaced road at a point NG Ref NJ 0656 5917; then southwestward along the said road to its junction with a track at NG Ref NJ 0609 5861; then northwestward along the said track to the eastern boundary of EW 7 (Forres East); then generally northwestward, northeastward, northwestward and southwestward along the eastern and northern boundaries of EW 7 to the northern boundary of EW 8 (Forres Central); then southwestward along the said boundary and continuing southwestward along the line of the Inverness to Aberdeen railway line to where it crosses the River Findhorn; then southward along the River Findhorn to NG Ref NJ 0076 5685; then westward along the line of field boundaries to the Speedie Burn at NG Ref NJ 0011 5678; then southwestward along the said burn and its continuation as the Darnaway Burn to the western boundary of The Moray Council; then generally northwestward along the said boundary to the point of commencement.

# Ward 10 Forres West and Altyre

Commencing at NG Ref NH 9752 5110 on the western boundary of The Moray Council where it meets the southern boundary of EW 9 (Finderne); then generally northeastward along the said EW boundary to the western boundary of EW 8 (Forres Central); then generally southeastward, southwestward and eastward along the western and southern boundaries of the said EW to the southern boundary of EW 7 (Forres East); then generally northeastward along the said boundary to NG Ref NJ 0547 5797 then southeastward along the B9010 to its junction with the access road leading to Chapletonmoss Farm at NG Ref NJ 0567 5773; then southwestward along the said road crossing the Marcassie Burn at NG Ref NJ 0520 5720; then continuing southwestward along the line of a field boundary and drain to NG Ref NJ 0494 5685; then southward to the disused Forres to Grantown railway line at NG Ref NJ 0487 5593; then southwestward along the said railway line to NG Ref NJ 0260 5218; then southeastward along the southern boundary of Cowgreens Wood and its continuation to its junction with the Petries Burn at NG Ref NJ 0341 5166; then southward along the said burn to NG Ref NJ 0343 5151; then northeastward along the undefined boundary to the Altyre Burn at NG Ref NJ 0426 5174; then southeastward along the said burn to NG Ref NJ 0461 5145; then eastward along the undefined boundary through Squirrel Wood to its junction with surfaced road at NG Ref NJ 0478 5142; then northeastward along the said road to NG Ref NJ 0482 5157; then northeastward along the southern boundary of Newtyle Forest to NG Ref NJ 0500 5155; then in a straight line to the Black Burn at NG Ref NJ 0574 5166; then eastward along the said burn and its continuation along the southern shore of Romach Loch and its continuation along the Black Burn to its junction with the burn of Alltnafourack; then southward along the said burn to its convergence with a tributary at NG Ref NJ 0767 5147; then southward along the said tributary to its source at NG Ref NJ 0762 5115; then southeastward along the fence line to the summit of Mill Buie; then southward in a straight line to the point where the track leading from Rochuln meets the western boundary of Loch Dallas; then generally southward along the track to Loch Trevie; then southwestward in a straight line to the summit of Carn Kitty at NG Ref NJ 0900 4275; then southward in a straight line to the southern boundary of The Moray Council at NG Ref NJ 0900 4180; then generally southwestward, northwestward, northward and northwestward along the southern and western boundaries of The Moray Council to the point of commencement.

# Ward 11 Burghsea

Commencing on the northern boundary of The Moray Council at NG Ref NJ 1940 7134; then southeastward along an undefined boundary to the B9040 road at NG Ref NJ 1964 7074; then southeastward to the unnamed road leading to Duffus at NG Ref NJ 1985 7028; then southwestward along the said unnamed road and continuing southwestward in a straight line to a point on the B9012 road at NG Ref NJ 1622 6860; then northwestward along the said road to a point in line with the northern boundary of the wooded area north of Inverugie; then southwestward to and along the said boundary to and continuing southwestward along the track leading to the unclassified road leading from Oldtown; then northward along the said unclassified road to the junction with the unclassified road leading to the B9013 road; then southwestward along the said unclassified road to NG Ref NJ 1280 6842; then southwestward in a straight line to the northern boundary of The Moray Council; then generally northwestward and northeastward along the said boundary to the point of commencement.

#### Ward 12 Heldon and Laich

# Ward 13 Lossiemouth East

Commencing on the northern boundary of The Moray Council at a point in line with the eastern curtilage of the cemetery; then southwestward in a straight line to and along the said curtilage to the B9103 road; then northwestward along the said road to the point it crosses the line of the dismantled railway; then southward along the line of the said railway to a point in line with the southern boundary of Oakenhead Wood; then northwestward along the said boundary to the access road to the property known as Sunbank; then generally westward along the said road to the western boundary of the said property; then northeastward along the said boundary to and northwestward along the line of a field boundary to the rear curtilages of the properties on the east side of Malin Place; then northward along the said curtilages to the rear curtilages of the properties on the eastern side of Boyd Anderson Drive; then northeastward along the said rear curtilages to the rear curtilages of the properties on the south side of Hillview Place; then northeastward along the said curtilages to the southern curtilage of Lossiemouth High School playing fields; then northeastward, northward and northeastward along the southern and eastern boundary of the said playing fields to Elgin Road; then northward along the said road to and northeastward along School Brae and Prospect Terrace to its junction with the footpath leading to Coulardhill; then northwestward to and along the said footpath to Coulardhill; then northwestward along Coulardhill to and northwestward along Kimberly Street to the access road to Beach Bar Public House; then northwestward along the said access and the prolongation thereof to the northern boundary of The Moray Council; then generally northeastward and southeastward along the said boundary to the point of commencement.

#### Ward 14 Lossiemouth West

Commencing on the River Lossie where the southern and eastern boundaries of EW 13 (Lossiemouth East) meet at NG Ref NJ 2428 6976; then southeastward, southward and westward along the River Lossie to NG Ref NJ 2496 6688; then westward along an undefined boundary to a field drain at NG Ref NJ 2454 6679; then northwestward along the said drain to its junction with the Spynie Canal at NG Ref NJ 2411 6735; then southwestward and westward along the said canal to NG Ref NJ 2336 6629 on EW 12; then generally northwestward along the said boundary to the northern boundary of The Moray Council; then eastward and southeastward along the said boundary to the western boundary of EW 13; then generally southwestward, southward, southwestward, southeastward, and northeastward along the western and southern boundaries of the said EW to the point of commencement.

## Ward 15 Lhanbryde and Birnie

Commencing at NG Ref NJ 2336 6629 where the southern boundary of EW 14 (Lossiemouth West) meets the eastern boundary of EW 12 (Heldon and Laich) at the Spynie Canal; then generally northeastward, southeastward, eastward and northeastward along the said EW boundary to the point where it crosses the B9103 road; then southward along the B9103 road to its junction with the access track to the property known as Blacklays; then southwestward along the said track to a point on the eastern perimeter of Blacklays Wood; then northwestward and southward around the perimeter of Blacklays Wood and continuing southward along the line of field boundaries to its junction with the access road to the property known as Sandyhillock at NG Ref NJ 2517 6529; then eastward along the said access road to NG Ref NJ 2553 6530; then southward, southeastward, southward, eastward, southward and southwestward along the line of field drains to the dismantled railway line at NG Ref NJ 2573 6400; then southeastward along the said dismantled railway line to its junction with Longhill Burn; then southeastward, eastward and southward along the said burn to the point it is crossed by the unclassified road at NG Ref NJ 2714 6209; then northeastward along the said road to a point in line with the eastern perimeter of the Crooked Wood at NG Ref NJ 2788 6233; then southward along the eastern perimeter of the said wood to NG Ref NJ 2787 6187; then southeastward along the line of a field boundary to the unclassified road at NG Ref NJ 2802 6167; then southwestward along the said road to Ref NJ 2797 6163; then southeastward, northeastward, southeastward and southward along the line of a watercourse to its exit from Loch Oire; then southward along the western shore of the said loch continuing to a point on the Aberdeen to Inverness railway line at NG Ref NJ 2882 6064; then southeastward along the said railway line to the point it crosses the Black Burn at NG Ref NJ 3010 5876; then southwestward and northwestward along the said burn and its continuation in a straight line through the unnamed wood to NG Ref NJ 2942 5856; then southwestward along the line of field boundaries crossing the B9103 road to NG Ref NJ 2910 5768; then westward along an undefined boundary to NG Ref NJ 2829 5761; then southeastward along an undefined boundary to the Red Burn at NG Ref NJ 2884 5653; then southward along the said burn and the Cushley Burn and its prolongation along the western perimeter of Teindland Forest to NG Ref NJ 2825 5390; then northwestward along an undefined boundary to NG Ref NJ 2800 5438; then westward along an undefined boundary to the summit at NG Ref NJ 2592 5453; then northwestward along an undefined boundary to NG Ref NJ 2512 5547; then southwestward along an undefined boundary to NG Ref NJ 2256 5342; then southwestward along an undefined boundary to NG Ref NJ 2223 5282; then generally southwestward along Sauchen Stripe Burn and continuing to the triangulation pillar on the summit of Pikey Hill at NG Ref NJ 2147 5134; then southwestward along an undefined boundary to the Stripe of Loan Burn at NG Ref NJ 2002 5000; then westward along the said burn to its confluence with Leanoch Burn; then northward along the said burn to the southern boundary of EW12 then northward along the said boundary to where it meets EW 5 (New Elgin - West); then generally

northeastward, southeastward and northeastward along the southern boundaries of EW 5, 6 (New Elgin – East) and 3 (Elgin – Cathedral); then generally northeastward and northwestward along the eastern boundaries of EWs 3, 2 (Elgin – Bishopmill East) and 12 to the point of commencement.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect (with minor modifications of a drafting nature) to proposals made by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland for the future electoral arrangements for the area of Moray Council. The proposals follow on the review of the whole of Scotland undertaken by the Commission in terms of Schedule 5 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973. The area of Moray Council is divided into 26 electoral wards as described in the Schedule to the Order. In terms

of paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994, the wards apply with effect from the ordinary election of councillors due to take place in May 1999.
