**The Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions)
Act 1989 (Partial Continuance) Order 1998**

Made - - - - *15th March 1998*
Coming into force - - *22nd March 1998*

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:
Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 27(6)(a) and (b) of the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1989(1), I hereby make the following Order:
