**The Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations  
1999**

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 302(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995<sup>(a)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1999 and shall come into force on 10th May 1999.

**Amendment of the Merchant Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1999**

2.—(1) The Merchant Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1996<sup>(b)</sup> shall be amended as follows.

(2) In Part I of the Schedule, in paragraph 2(2)(a):

- (i) for “£23.66” there shall be substituted “£24.40”; and
- (ii) for “£26.75” there shall be substituted “£27.60”.
