- **1.** This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice Act 1991 (Commencement No. 3) (Amendment) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 1st June 1999.
- **2.** Article 2(5) of, and Schedule 3 to, the Criminal Justice Act 1991 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1992(**2**) are hereby revoked.
- **3.** The provisions of the Criminal Justice Act 1991 referred to in the left-hand column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters described in the right-hand column of that Schedule) shall come into force on 1st June 1999.
