**The Air Navigation (General) (Second
Amendment) Regulations 1999**

Made - - - - *10th May 1999*
Coming into force - - *14th May 1999*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 4(5) of Schedule 5 to the Air Navigation (No. 2) Order 1995⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (General) (Second Amendment) Regulations 1999 and shall come into force on 14th May 1999.
2. The Air Navigation (General) Regulations 1993⁽²⁾ shall be further amended by inserting after regulation 18 the following:

“Airborne Collision Avoidance System

18A. For the purposes of paragraph 4(5) of Schedule 5 to the Air Navigation (No. 2) Order 1995, the prescribed requirements for an airborne collision avoidance system shall be the requirements for ACASII equipment set out in Volume 4 Chapter 4 of Annex 10 (first edition) to the Chicago Convention.”.
