1999**

Made - - - - - 9th June 1999

Coming into force 1st August 1999

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(5) of the Public Records Act 1958(a) and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Record Office (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1999 and shall come into force on 1st August 1999.

2. In the Schedule to the Public Record Office (Fees) Regulations 1999(b), paragraph 6.1(ix) (Additional finishes) shall be omitted.
