FUNCTIONS EXERCISABLE IN OR AS REGARDS SCOTLAND: GENERAL

Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 (c. 48)

10. The Secretary of State's functions under sections 145 and 150 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 (c. 48)(1) (functions of being consulted by the Lord Chancellor on appointments of chairman and deputy chairman of the Copyright Tribunal and on rules for regulating proceedings before that Tribunal) are to be treated, for the purposes of section 63 of the 1998 Act, as being exercisable in or as regards Scotland.
