**The Export of Goods (Control) (Iraq and  
Kuwait Sanctions) (Amendment) Order 1999**

*Made - - - - 23rd June 1999*

*Coming into force - - 14th July 1999*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(2)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Iraq and Kuwait Sanctions) (Amendment) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 14th July 1999.

2. In article 3 of the Export of Goods (Control) (Iraq and Kuwait Sanctions) Order 1990<sup>(3)</sup>, the words “in writing” shall be inserted after the word “licence” where it first appears.
