## PART III

### COMPOSITION OF TEMPORARY GOVERNING BODIES

### **Temporary staff governors**

**14.**—(1) Notwithstanding provision to the contrary in the relevant paragraphs, and subject to paragraph (2)—

- (a) the local education authority, where the new school is or will be a community, community special, voluntary controlled or foundation special school, or a foundation school proposals for the establishment of which were published by a local education authority, or
- (b) the promoters, where the new school is or will be a voluntary aided school or a foundation school proposals for the establishment of which were published by promoters,

shall-

- (i) determine whether a temporary staff governor should be included on the temporary governing body of the new school in accordance with Schedule 9 to the 1998 Act (as modified by these Regulations); and, if they so determine,
- (ii) appoint a temporary staff governor to the temporary governing body.

(2) No person shall be appointed under paragraph (1) as a temporary staff governor unless he is employed to work at a school maintained by a local education authority at the time when he is appointed.
