**The Court of Protection (Enduring Powers of Attorney)  
(Amendment) Rules 1999**

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred on him by sections 106 and 108 of the Mental Health Act 1983<sup>(a)</sup> and with the consent of the Treasury, makes the following Rules:

**1.** These Rules may be cited as the Court of Protection (Enduring Powers of Attorney) (Amendment) Rules 1999 and shall come into force on 1st October 1999.

**2.** Column 2 of Schedule 2 to the Court of Protection (Enduring Powers of Attorney) Rules 1994<sup>(b)</sup> shall be amended as follows:

- (a) the figure “£75” shall be substituted for the figure “£50”;
- (b) the figure “£25” shall be substituted for the figure “£10”.
