1999**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), hereby makes the following Order:

1. In Schedule 3 to the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994(c) there shall be inserted after “Ethiopia”,—  
“Indonesia”.

2. This Order shall come into force on 16th September 1999.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note does not form part of the Order)*

This Order is consequential on the Order implementing the Common Position of the European Union requiring an arms embargo on certain exports to Indonesia. It removes the exception conferred by Article 3 of the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994 from the requirement to obtain an export licence in respect of goods in transit or for transshipment and which are to be exported within 30 days of their importation.

*Made - - - - - 17th September 1999*

*Coming into force - - - 18th September 1999*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939<sup>(a)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(b)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 5) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 18th September 1999.

2. The Order made and coming into force on 16th September 1999 which amends Schedule 3 to the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994<sup>(c)</sup> and is numbered S.I. 1999/2609 may be cited as “the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1999”.

3. In Article 2 of the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1999 there shall be added, “and may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1999” after the words “16th September 1999”.
