PROVISIONS IN SCHEDULE 4 TO THE INCOME SUPPORT REGULATIONS AS AMENDED BY THIS ORDER

Residential care homes

- **6.**—(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2) and paragraphs 8 to 11, where the accommodation provided for the claimant is a residential care home for persons in need of personal care by virtue of—
 - (a) old age, the appropriate amount shall be £218.00 per week;
 - (b) past or present mental disorder but excluding mental handicap, the appropriate amount shall be £230.00 per week;
 - (c) past or present drug or alcohol dependence, the appropriate amount shall be £230.00 per week.
 - (d) mental handicap, the appropriate amount shall be £262.00 per week;
 - (e) physical disablement, the appropriate amount shall be—
 - (i) in the case of a person to whom paragraph 8 applies, £298.00 per week, or
 - (ii) in any other case, £218.00 per week; or
 - (f) any condition not falling within sub-paragraphs (a) to (e) above, the appropriate amount shall be £218.00 per week.
