The Social Security Act 1998 (Commencement No. 12 and Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999

Citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Social Security Act 1998 (Commencement No. 12 and Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999.
 - (2) In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - (a) "the Act" means the Social Security Act 1998;
 - (b) "the 1997 Regulations" means the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) (Appeals) Regulations 1997(1);
 - (c) "the Adjudication Regulations" means the Social Security (Adjudication) Regulations 1995(2);
 - (d) "legally qualified panel member" has the meaning it bears in regulation 1(3) of the Regulations;
 - (e) "the No. 8 Order" means the Social Security Act 1998 (Commencement No. 8, and Savings and Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999(3);
 - (f) "the No. 9 Order" means the Social Security Act 1998 (Commencement No. 9, and Savings and Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999(4);
 - (g) "the No. 11 Order" means the Social Security Act 1998 (Commencement No. 11, and Savings and Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999(5);
 - (h) "the Regulations" means the Social Security and Child Support (Decisions and Appeals) Regulations 1999(6); and
 - (i) "relevant benefit" means income support, child's special allowance under section 56 of the Contributions and Benefits Act or, as the case may be, a social fund payment mentioned in section 138(1)(a) or (2) of that Act,

and references to sections and Schedules are references to sections of, and Schedules to, the Act.
