## **CUSTOMS AND EXCISE**

The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1999

Made 11th February 1999 - - -*Coming into force* - -12th February 1999

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(1) and now vested in him(2), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 12th February 1999.

2. In Schedule 3 to the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994(3), there shall be inserted after "Democratic Republic of the Congo"-

"Eritrea

Ethiopia".
