**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE**

**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2)  
Order 1999**

*Made - - - - 11th February 1999*

*Coming into force 12th February 1999*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939<sup>(a)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(b)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 12th February 1999.

**2.** In Schedule 3 to the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994<sup>(c)</sup>, there shall be inserted after “Democratic Republic of the Congo”–

“Eritrea  
Ethiopia”.
