The Pesticides (Maximum Residue Levels in Crops, Food and Feeding Stuffs) (England and Wales) Regulations 1999

Interpretation

2.—(1) In these Regulations—

"EEA State" means a State which is a Contracting Party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area signed at Oporto on 2nd May 1992(1) as adjusted by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 17th March 1993(2);

"product" means any crop, food or feeding stuff specified in Schedule 2;

"putting into circulation" means any handing over, whether or not for a consideration, of any product—

- (a) in the case of fruit and vegetables, after they have been harvested, and
- (b) in any other case, at any time.

"the Residues Directives" means Council Directive $\frac{86}{362}$ (EEC(3) (as amended by Council Directives $\frac{88}{298}$ (EEC(4), $\frac{90}{654}$ (EEC(5), $\frac{93}{57}$ (EEC(6), $\frac{94}{29}$ (EC(7), $\frac{95}{39}$ (EC(8), $\frac{96}{33}$ /EC(9), $\frac{97}{41}$ (EC(10) and Commission Directives $\frac{97}{1}$ (EC(11), $\frac{98}{82}$ (EC(12), $\frac{1999}{65}$ /EC(13) and $\frac{1999}{11}$ (EC(14), together with Council Directive $\frac{86}{363}$ (EEC(15) (as amended by Council Directives $\frac{93}{57}$ /EEC, $\frac{94}{29}$ /EC, $\frac{95}{39}$ /EC, $\frac{96}{33}$ /EC, $\frac{97}{41}$ /EC and Commission Directives $\frac{97}{11}$ (EC, $\frac{98}{82}$ /EC and $\frac{1999}{11}$ /EC) and Council Directive $\frac{90}{642}$ /EEC(16) (as amended by Council Directives $\frac{93}{58}$ /EEC(17), $\frac{94}{30}$ /EC(18), $\frac{95}{38}$ /EC(19), $\frac{95}{61}$ /EC(20), $\frac{96}{32}$ /EC(21), $\frac{97}{41}$ /EC and Commission Directives $\frac{97}{71}$ /EC, $\frac{98}{82}$ /EC, $\frac{1999}{65}$ /EC and $\frac{1999}{71}$ /EC).

(2) The words and expressions "dried", "processed", "composite food", "drying" and "processing" when used either in regulation 4 or in paragraphs (d) and (e) of regulation 6 shall have

the same meaning as when used in the Residues Directives and any related expressions shall be construed accordingly.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations, in relation to a pesticide, to a pesticide residue is a reference to the substance named in column 2 of Schedule 1 opposite the reference to that pesticide in column 1 of that Schedule.

(4) Any reference in these Regulations to a Schedule or to a regulation shall be construed as a reference respectively to a Schedule to these Regulations or a regulation in these Regulations.

(5) Any reference in any Schedule to these Regulations to any product, figure or pesticide includes any qualifying words relating to that product, figure or pesticide in that Schedule.
