**REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE**

**The Returning Officers (Parliamentary Constituencies)  
(England) (Amendment) Order 1999**

*Made* - - - - - *23rd March 1999*

*Coming into force* *5th April 1999*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 28(1)(b) of the Representation of the People Act 1983(a), hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Returning Officers (Parliamentary Constituencies) (England) (Amendment) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 5th April 1999.

**2.** Schedule 3 to the Returning Officers (Parliamentary Constituencies) (England) Order 1995(b) shall be amended by substituting for the district named in the right-hand column of that Schedule opposite to the name of any county constituency which—

(a) is listed in the left-hand column of that Schedule, and

(b) is also listed in the left-hand column of the Table below,

the district named in the right-hand column of that Table opposite to the name of the county constituency in question.
