SCHEDULE 1

Article 2

The Funded Operations

1. All the operations of Ordnance Survey including in particular: maintaining and enhancing the National Topographic Database; delivering survey and mapping activities in the national interest; providing national coverage of medium and small scale maps; making available a range of products, licences and services to meet the needs of customers in the United Kingdom, in Europe and worldwide; providing survey, mapping and geospatial information products and services in support of broader government policies; developing, maintaining and enhancing other geospatial datasets; contributing to any government policy to develop partnerships with other public and private sector bodies; and providing advice to government on all survey, mapping and geographical information matters.

2. Operations incidental, conducive or otherwise ancillary to these operations.

SCHEDULE 2

Article 4

Assets and Liabilities Appropriated to the Fund

Assets

Equipment and facilities (including the management system of the national topographic database), fixtures and motor vehicles, as at 1st April 1999 used or allocated for use in the operations of Ordnance Survey.

Current assets as at 1st April 1999 used or allocated for use in or arising from the funded operations as carried on up to that date.

Liabilities

Creditors and accruals as at 1st April 1999 in relation to the funded operations.
