The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 8 of the Law of Distress Amendment Act 1888(a), and section 3 of the Law of Distress Amendment Act 1895(b), hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Distress for Rent (Amendment) Rules 2000 and shall come into force:
 - (a) as to rule 2(b), on 2nd January 2001; and
 - (b) as to the remainder of these Rules, on 3rd July 2000.
 - (2) In these Rules "the principal rules" means the Distress for Rent Rules 1988(c).

Amendments to Distress for Rent Rules 1988

- 2. The following entries in Appendix 3 to the principal rules shall be deleted:—
 - (a) the entry relating to Lichfield; and
 - (b) the entry relating to Workington.
- 3. In question 8 of Form 3 (Application for Certificate to Levy Distress) in Appendix 2 to the principal rules, the words from "In support of your answer" to "your home address" shall be deleted.
