**The Herefordshire Primary Care Trust (Establishment)  
Amendment Order 2000**

*Made - - - - 19th September 2000*

*Coming into force 2nd October 2000*

The Secretary of State for Health, in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 16A(1), (2) and (3) and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(a)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, following compliance with the consultation requirements contained in regulations made under section 16A(5) of the Act<sup>(b)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Herefordshire Primary Care Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2000 and shall come into force on 2nd October 2000.

**Amendment of Establishment Order**

2. In the Herefordshire Primary Care Trust (Establishment) Order 2000<sup>(c)</sup>—
- (a) in article 1(2), the definition of “community health services” shall be omitted; and
  - (b) article 8 (exercise of functions) shall be omitted.

This Order amends the establishment order (“the Order”) of the Herefordshire Primary Care Trust (“the trust”), a Primary Care Trust established by Order under section 16A of the National Health Service Act 1977 (“the Act”) by removing the restriction in article 8 of the Order whereby, in the exercise of functions, the trust shall not provide services directly to patients, other than community health services.
