**The Children (Allocation of Proceedings) (Amendment) Order 2000**

*Made* - - - - - *26th September 2000*  
*Laid before Parliament* *2nd October 2000*  
*Coming into force* - - - *23rd October 2000*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Part I of Schedule 11 to the Children Act 1989(1), hereby makes the following Order:—

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Children (Allocation of Proceedings) (Amendment) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 23rd October 2000.

**2.** In Schedule 1 to the Children (Allocation of Proceedings) Order 1991(2), under the heading “South Eastern Circuit”, there shall be inserted “Barnet County Court”.
