The Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 2000

Made---4th December 2000Laid before Parliament8th December 2000Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1(2)to (5)

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 67, 69 and 213(2) of the Water Industry Act 1991(1) and, in relation to England, section 77(3) and (4) of that Act(2), and in exercise of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:
