**The Petty Sessions Areas (Amendment) Order 2000**

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 4 of the Justices of the Peace Act 1997(1), makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Areas (Amendment) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 1st April 2000.

2. For the Schedule to the Petty Sessions Areas Order 1999(2) there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order.
