**The National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2000**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 121 and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation, commencement and extent

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on 31st March 2000.

(2) These Regulations extend to England only.

Amendment of regulation 1 of the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) Amendment Regulations 2000

2. At the end of regulation 1(1) of the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) Amendment Regulations 2000(b) there shall be added the words “and shall come into force on 1st April 2000”.
